TICKET INFORMATION

Monthly Pass: Save over 30%. Good for unlimited travel between the fare zones indicated on the ticket during a calendar month. The pass is for the exclusive use of the purchaser and is not transferable.

10-Ride Ticket: Occasional commuters or recreational travelers save 15% off one-way fares. One 10-Ride can be shared by people riding together. Ticket is valid one year from date of purchase.

One Way Ticket: Good for one-way travel between the fare zones indicated on the ticket. Valid for one year from date of purchase.

Weekend Pass: Offers unlimited rides on both Saturday and Sunday.

Pace PlusBus: Monthly pass holders can purchase a Pace PlusBus sticker for unlimited travel on all Pace suburban buses. Pace buses connect with Metra trains at many stations.

Link-Up: Monthly pass holders can purchase a Link-Up sticker for connecting travel on CTA and Pace buses. CTA usage is restricted to A.M. and P.M. weekday rush hours.

Family Fares: Allow up to 3 children age 11 and under to ride **FREE** with a fare-paying adult on weekends and holidays.

Young Adult Fares: On weekends and holidays, youngsters 12 to 17 years of age ride for half fare.

Children's Weekday Fares: Allow children 6 and under to ride free when accompanied by a fare-paying adult (up to 3 children free per adult); children 7-11 save 50% over one-way fares.

Seniors Ride Free Program: Senior Citizens, 65 or older and living in the six-county region of Cook, DuPage, Kane, Lake, McHenry or Will are eligible to ride free by presenting their RTA-issued Reduced Fare Permit to the on-board personnel.

Disability/Senior Citizen Fares: Customers with Disabilities who have an RTA-issued Reduced Fare Permit are eligible for a reduced fare ticket. If you are enrolled in the Illinois Circuit Breaker Program and have a RTA Issued Circuit Permit, you are eligible to ride free. Seniors, who are ineligible for the Seniors Ride Free Program due to residency restrictions are still eligible for a reduced fare by presenting their Reduced Fare Permit or Medicare Card.

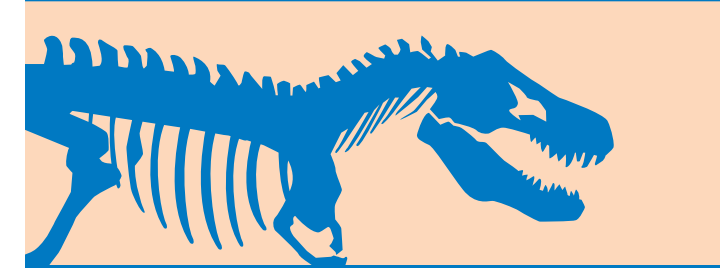
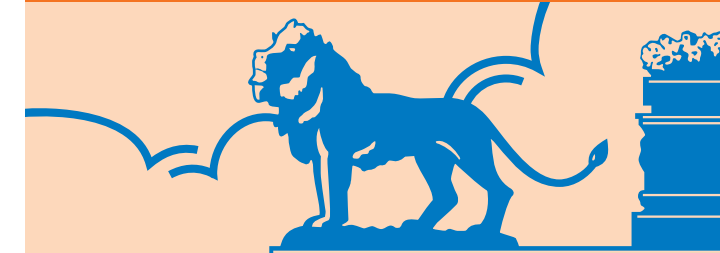

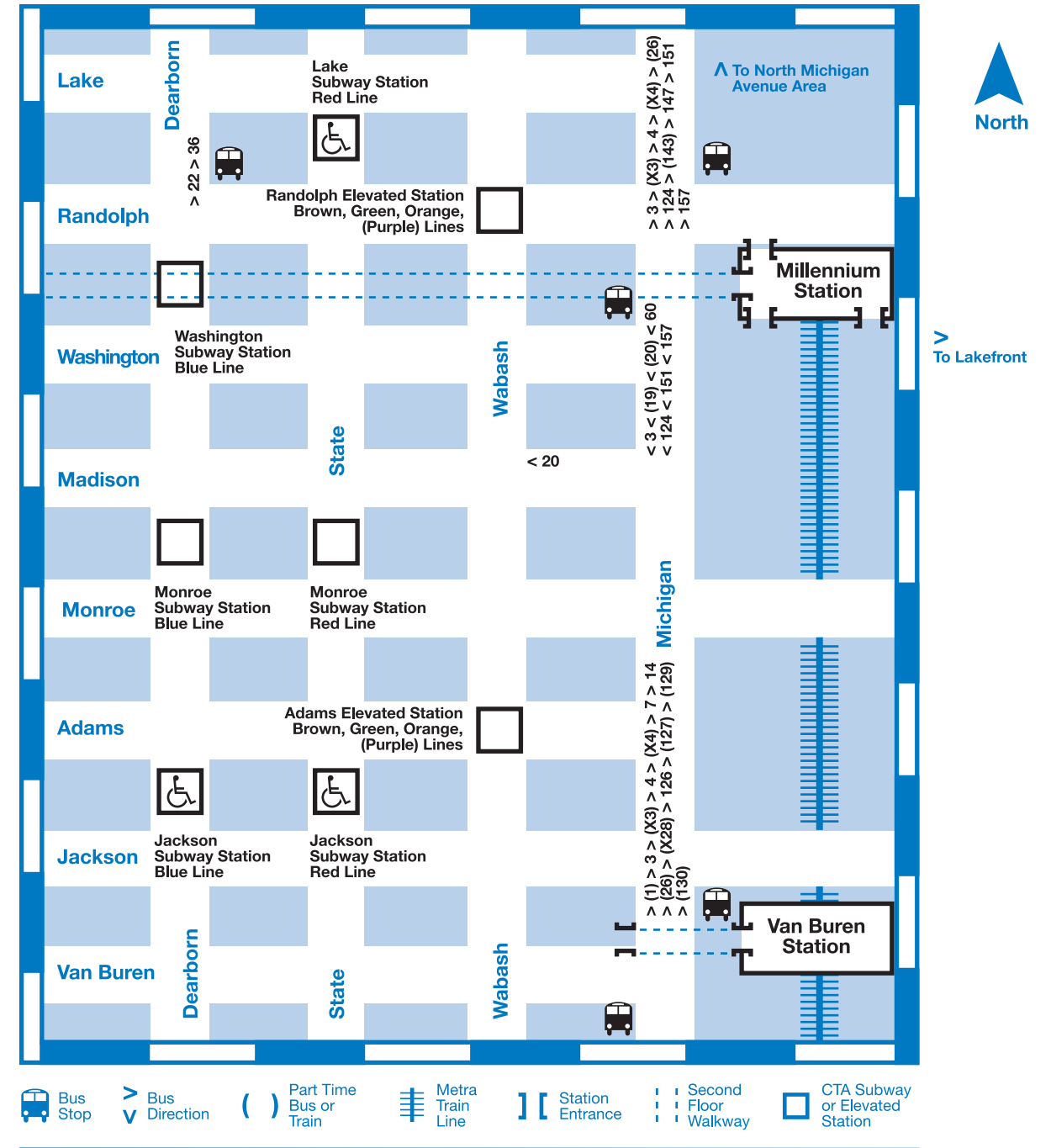
Millennium, Van Buren & Museum Campus Stations Travel Guide

- **Blue Line** trains (Dearborn Street subway) and **Red Line** trains (State Street subway) run at all times.
- **Green Line** trains (Loop "L") run as follows: Weekdays - Southbound 4:20am-1:20am. Northbound (Westbound) 4:15am-1:20am. Saturdays - Southbound 6:20am-1:20am. Northbound (Westbound) 6:15am-1:20am. Sundays/Holidays - Southbound 6:50am-1:20am. Northbound (Westbound) 6:45am-1:20am.
- **Purple Line Express** trains (Loop "L") run Weekdays 6:00am-10:10am and 3:10pm-7:10pm.
- **Orange Line** trains (Loop "L") run Weekdays 4:20am-1:20am; Saturdays 4:50am-1:20am; Sundays/Holidays 5:50am-11:50pm.
- **Brown Line** trains run Weekdays/Saturdays 5:00am-1:00am; Sundays/Holidays 7:15am-12:15am.
- **Pink Line** trains (Loop "L") run daily 4:20am-12:00m.
