TICKET INFORMATION

Monthly Pass: Save over 40%. Good for unlimited travel between the fare zones indicated on the ticket during a calendar month. The pass is for the exclusive use of the purchaser and is not transferable.

10-Ride Ticket: Occasional commuters or recreational travelers save 20% off one-way fares. One 10-Ride can be shared by people riding together. Ticket is valid one year from date of purchase.

One Way Ticket: Good for one-way travel between the fare zones indicated on the ticket. Valid for one year from date of purchase.

\$7 Weekend Pass: Offers unlimited rides on both Saturday and Sunday.

Pace PlusBus: Monthly pass holders can purchase a Pace PlusBus sticker for unlimited travel on all Pace suburban buses. Pace buses connect with Metra trains at many stations.

Link-Up: Monthly pass holders can purchase a Link-Up sticker for connecting travel on CTA and Pace buses. CTA usage is restricted to A.M. and P.M. weekday rush hours.

Family Fares: Allow up to 3 children age 11 and under to ride **FREE** with a fare-paying adult on weekends and holidays.

Young Adult Fares: On weekends and holidays, youngsters 12 to 17 years of age ride for half fare.

Children's Weekday Fares: Allow children 6 and under to ride free when accompanied by a fare-paying adult (up to 3 children free per adult); children 7–11 save 50% over one-way fares.

Seniors Ride Free Program: Senior Citizens, 65 or older and living in the six-county region of Cook, DuPage, Kane, Lake, McHenry or Will are eligible to ride free by presenting their RTA-issued Reduced Fare Permit to the on-board personnel.

Disability/Senior Citizen Fares: Customers with Disabilities who have an RTA-issued Reduced Fare Permit are eligible for a reduced fare ticket. If you are enrolled in the Illinois Circuit Breaker Program and have a RTA Issued Circuit Permit, you are eligible to ride free. Seniors, who are ineligible for the Seniors Ride Free Program due to residency restrictions are still eligible for a reduced fare by presenting their Reduced Fare Permit or Medicare Card.

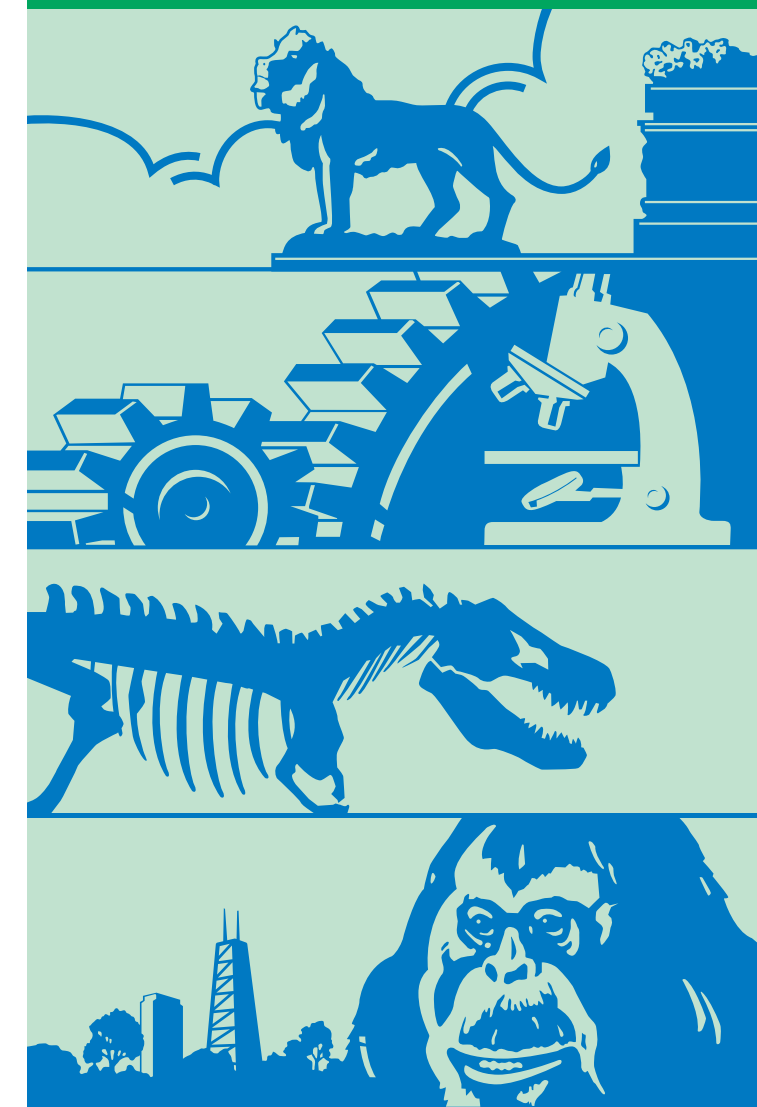

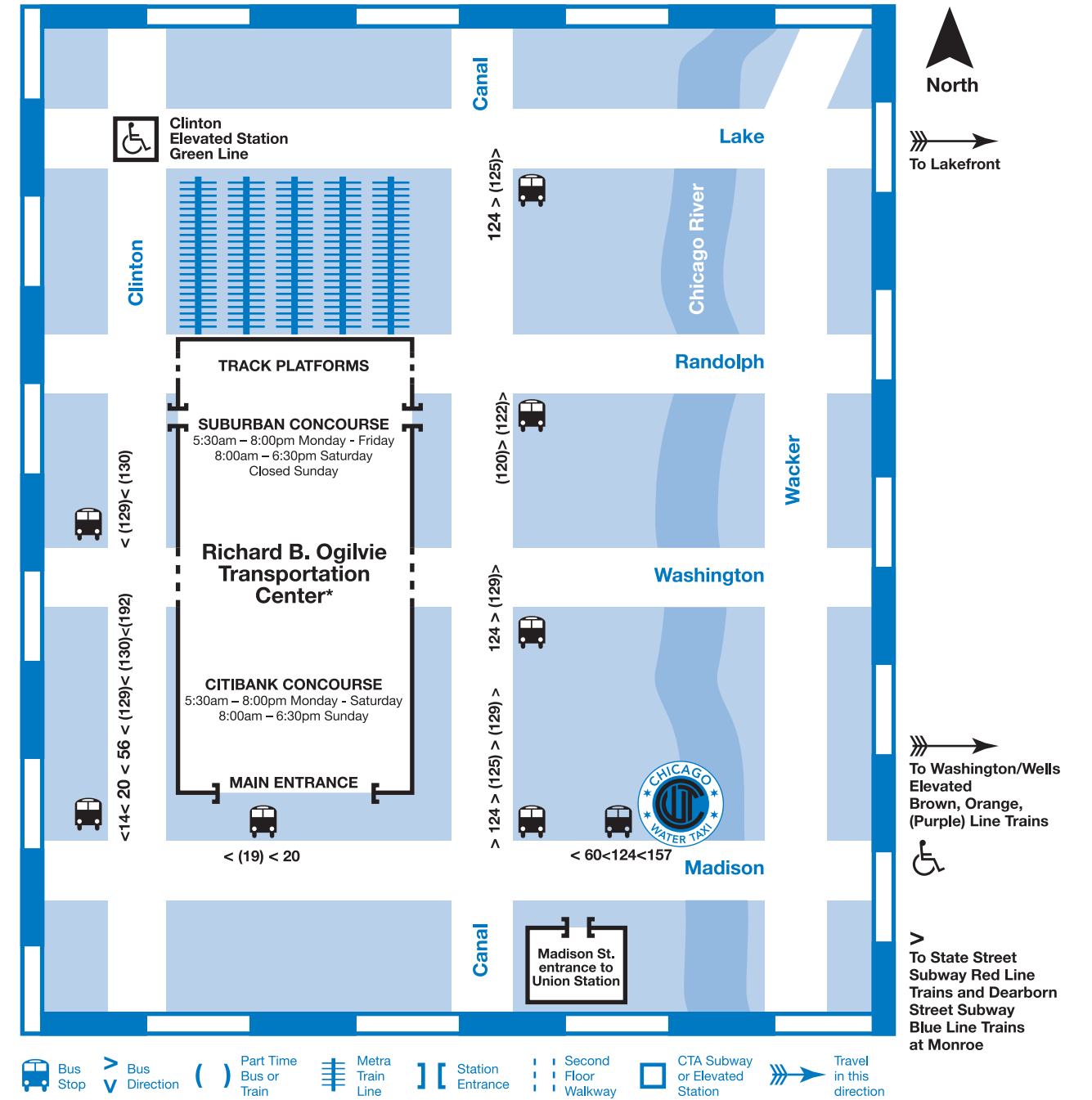

Art Institute	14 or 56 on Clinton at Madison. Exit at Wabash. Walk 1 block east and 1 block south.
Briar St. Theater's Blue Man Group 	Walk 3 blocks east on Madison to Wells. Board the Brown Line or Purple Line elevated train (at Washington/Wells ♿ station) to Belmont ♿ walk 2 blocks east on Belmont to Halsted.
Chicago Board of Trade/Chicago Board Options Exchange	Walk 3 blocks east on Madison to Wells. Board the Brown Line elevated train (at Washington/Wells ♿ station) to LaSalle.

Civic Opera House	Walk east on Madison 1 block to Wacker.

NOTE:	To avoid paying a second cash fare, purchase CTA farecard or pass from dispenser in Ogilvie train concourse or from CVS pharmacy (Mon-Sat) at Metra Market or on Madison at river.



- **Red Line** trains (State Street subway) and **Blue Line** trains (Dearborn Street subway) run at all times.
- **Brown Line** trains (Washington/Wells ♿ elevated) run Weekdays/Saturdays 5:00am-1:00am; Sundays/holidays 7:15am-12:15am.
- **Orange Line** trains (Washington/Wells ♿ elevated) run Weekdays 4:25am-1:25am; Saturdays 4:55am-1:25am; Sundays/holidays 5:55am-11:55pm.
- **Purple Line Express** trains (Washington/Wells ♿ elevated) run Weekdays 6:10am-10:25am and 3:25pm-7:20pm.
- **Green Line** trains (Clinton/Lake elevated ♿) run as follows:
