TICKET INFORMATION

Monthly Pass: Save over 30%. Good for unlimited travel between the fare zones indicated on the ticket during a calendar month. The pass is for the exclusive use of the purchaser and is not transferable.

10-Ride Ticket: Occasional commuters or recreational travelers save 15% off one-way fares. One 10-Ride can be shared by people riding together. Ticket is valid one year from date of purchase.

One Way Ticket: Good for one-way travel between the fare zones indicated on the ticket. Valid for one year from date of purchase.

\$5 Weekend Pass: Offers unlimited rides on both Saturday and Sunday.

Pace PlusBus: Monthly pass holders can purchase a Pace PlusBus sticker for unlimited travel on all Pace suburban buses. Pace buses connect with Metra trains at many stations.

Link-Up: Monthly pass holders can purchase a Link-Up sticker for connecting travel on CTA and Pace buses. CTA usage is restricted to A.M. and P.M. weekday rush hours.

Family Fares: Allow up to 3 children under 12 to ride FREE with a fare-paying adult on weekends and holidays.

Young Adult Fares: On weekends and holidays, youngsters 12 to 17 years of age ride for half fare.

Children's Weekday Fares: Allow children 6 and under to ride free when accompanied by a fare-paying adult (up to 3 children free per adult); children 7-11 save 50% over one-way fares.

Seniors Ride Free Program: Senior Citizens, 65 or older and living in the six-county region of Cook, DuPage, Kane, Lake, McHenry or Will are eligible to ride free by presenting their RTA-issued Reduced Fare Permit to the on-board personnel.

Disability/Senior Citizen Fares: Customers with Disabilities who have an RTA-issued Reduced Fare Permit are eligible for a reduced fare ticket. Seniors, who are ineligible for the Seniors Ride Free Program due to residency restrictions are still eligible for a reduced fare by presenting their Reduced Fare Permit or Medicare Card.

Buy pre-valued, full-fare Transit Cards at Currency Exchanges, select Jewel and Dominick's food stores, and at transitchicago.com for \$10 or \$20.

REDUCED FARE TRANSIT CARD PACKS: Buy at Currency Exchanges, select Jewel and Dominick's food stores, and at transitchicago.com. Add value at station farecard machines.

PASSES: Offer unlimited rides when activated with first use. Buy at Currency Exchanges, select Jewel and Dominick's food stores, and at transitchicago.com. Cannot be shared or recharged. 30-day passes are valid on CTA and Pace.

LINK-UP PASS (STICKER OR FARECARD AVAILABLE): Valid week days on CTA (6 a.m.-9:30 a.m., and 3:30 p.m.-7 p.m.) and on Pace (any time). Sold by Metra; use with Metra monthly ticket.

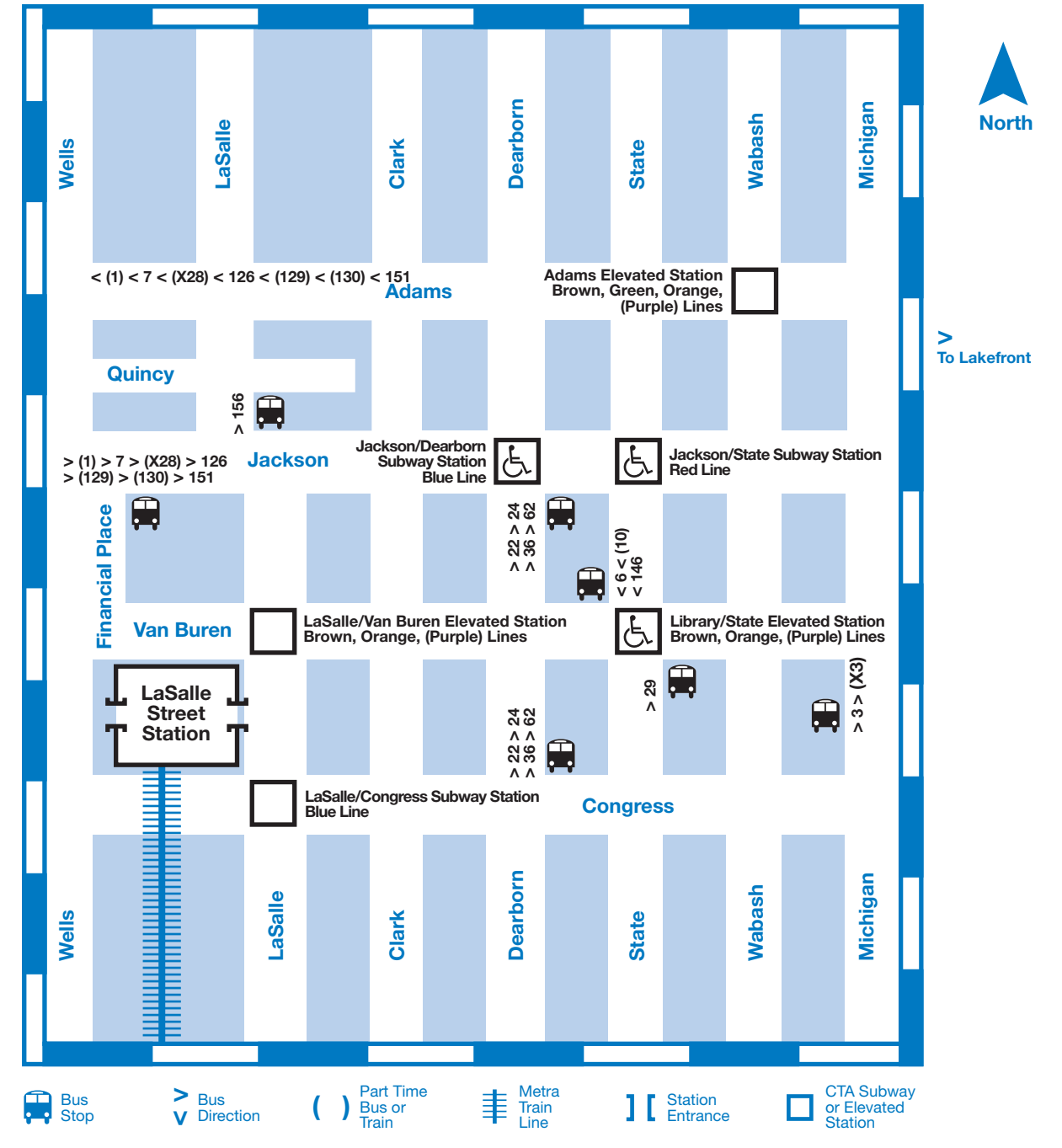
