We were questioned, both officers were writing things down, and we were released. They took our drivers licenses, our health insurance card, and other identification given to them by my wife. We would lke to see the police report regarding this incident. We were waiting for a train, and because we were anxious and in a hurry, our first instincts were to get on our train (12:35, South Shore Line) and go home and get away from the situation... which we did, so we don't have officer's names or an incident number. Things were written, and we would like to see the report. Please advise us on how to proceed.
