Dear Ms. Guerin:

We are in receipt of your request for information pursuant to the Illinois Freedom of Information Act, 5 ILCS 140/1 *et seq.*

On April 19, 2016, we received your request for a copy of a report for an incident involving yourself and another female passenger which occurred on April 14, 2015, at 7:45 a.m., while on a train from Brookfield to Chicago (“**Request**”).

We contacted you by email on April 20, 2016, asking for verification that the report you were seeking was for an incident occurring on April 14, 2015. You responded that same day confirming the April 14, 2015 date.

You phoned our office on April 25 and left a voice mail indicating that the date originally provided in your Request was incorrect and that the incident actually occurred on April 14, 2016.

After performing a diligent search of Metra’s records, we have been unable to locate any records responsive to your Request. Metra’s Police Department states they do not have any record of your name located in their reporting system. As this incident occurred on a BNSF train line, we reached out to the BNSF for any record that would be responsive to your Request; however, we were advised that no such report containing your name was located for 2015 or 2016. The BNSF states that no report was filed regarding this incident, as the parties involved apologized to each another and left Union Station.
