We are in receipt of your request under the Illinois Freedom of Information Act, 5 ILCS 140/1 et seq. ("FOIA").

## I. <u>Background</u>

On August 29, 2016, we received your request for all records, written reports, and statements pertaining to the fatality involving **and the statement**, who was struck by a Metra train on June 28, 2016 ("**Request**").

We sent you an email on September 2 and left you a voicemail on September 12, indicating that the requested records concern a minor; we asked that you provide verification of your representation of the estate of the state of the section of the se

## II. Denial

The requested records contain information regarding the disposition of a case involving a minor. Section 7(1)(a) of FOIA authorizes units of government to withhold "Information specifically prohibited from disclosure by federal or State law or rules and regulations implementing federal or State law." 5 ILCS 140/7(1)(a). The Juvenile Court Act, in pertinent part, states that "Law enforcement officers ... may not disclose the identity of any minor in releasing information to the general public as to the arrest, investigation or disposition of any case involving a minor." 705 ILCS 405/1-7(E). As noted above, the records contain information involving a minor and as such, it has been determined by Attorney Thomas Stuebner that your Request for these records is denied.

You may re-submit your request for these records by sending verification of your representation of the estate of

## III. <u>Right of Review</u>

You have the right to have the denial of your Request reviewed by the Public Access Counselor ("**PAC**") of the Illinois Attorney General's Office. 5 ILCS 140/9.5(a). You can file your Request for Review with the PAC by writing to:

If you choose to file a Request for Review with the PAC, you must do so within 60 calendar days of the date of this denial letter. 5 ILCS 140/9.5(a). Please note that you must include a copy of your original FOIA request and this denial letter when filing a Request for Review with the PAC.

You also have the right to seek judicial review of your denial by filing a lawsuit in the circuit court. 5 ILCS 140/11.
