Dear Mr. Aguilera:

We are in receipt of your request for information pursuant to the Illinois Freedom of Information Act, 5 ILCS 140/1 *et seq.* ("**FOIA**").

On October 13, 2016, we received your request for the following information in connection with the North Central Service line, specifically of the section between the Wheeling Metra Station and Prospect Heights Metra Station:

- 1. Train type;
- 2. The average train speed;
- 3. Engines per train;
- 4. Railway cars per train;
- 5. Average train operation;
- 6. If the rail has any whistles or horns; and
- 7. If the track is bolted

("Request").

In response to your Request, Metra's Transportation Department is providing the following passenger rail information:

- 1. Train type: *Diesel*;
- 2. Average Train Speed: Maximum track speed is 60 miles per hour, trains making station stops are averaging 40 miles per hour;
- 3. Engines per train: There is one engine per train;
- 4. Railway cars per train: On average, there are between 4 to 6 cars per train;
- 5. Average train operation: *There are 22 trains running Monday through Friday with no trains operating on the weekend*;
- 6. If the rail has any whistles or horns: *The entire North Central Service line is a quiet zone*; and
- 7. If the track is bolted: The track is a Continual Welded Rail.
